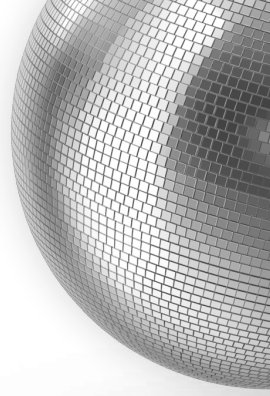


SATURDAY NIGHT FEVER

"Well, you can tell by the way I use my walk, I'm a woman's man: no time to talk." With these classic words from the Bee Gees' "Stayin' Alive," *Saturday Night Fever*, a musical based on the 1977 film of the same name, we're introduced to Tony Manero as he struts downstage.

The Arts Center's summer production (June 20 - July 29) follows Manero, a young Brooklyn native known locally for his dance prowess, as he prepares for a dance competition at the discotheque

where he's the Dance King, falls in love with his partner, Stephanie, and navigates between a disapproving family and troubled group of friends.

Based on the film that became a cultural phenomenon, the electrifying score is packed with legendary hits from the Bee Gees including the classics!

The production is directed by Antoinette DiPietropolo, who is new to the Arts Center, but a veteran of the stage. She is not only a director but choreographer, dancer and actor as well. "I've heard amazing things about the Arts Center from my colleagues in New York City, and I'm excited to be directing this incredible cast."

Winner of *American Idol* Season 12, Candice Glover, plays the role of Candy! A nearby native of St. Helena Island, Candice says she's thrilled to be making her Arts Center debut. Candice recently dipped her toe in the Broadway waters with her performance in the play *Home for the Holidays*, at the August Wilson Theatre this past holiday season.
