The second annual six-week cultural celebration, sponsored by the Arts & Cultural Council of Hilton Head (ACCHH), will be held September 27 - November 15. This regional event, organized in honor of National Arts and Humanities month, will showcase the work of arts, culture and history organizations, artists, performers, and authors residing and working in the Hilton Head/Bluffton area.



The Opening Night event is Thursday September 27 at 5 PM at the Coastal Discovery Museum with free guided public art tours, poetry readings, ticket giveaways, exhibitions, performances and refreshments. In addition to the kick-off of Crescendo, it's also the opening party to honor the 2018 Public Art Exhibition on Hilton Head Island. Nineteen large-scale sculptures will be installed on-site at Honey Horn with an additional piece installed at the Hilton Head Island Airport through January 31. The event is free and open to the public.

"Building on the success of our inaugural Crescendo event last year, we've added even more engaging, informative and educational events to the calendar," said Natalie Hefter, Crescendo chair.

The 2018 Crescendo Celebration features more than 80 unique arts and cultural programs, concerts, theatrical productions, museum and gallery exhibits, lectures, poetry readings, dance performances, historical tours, and educational offerings.

According to ACCHH President, Patti Maurer, "Arts and cultural patrons of all ages are invited to help celebrate our community by attending the myriad of outstanding cultural programs offered, many free or reasonably priced."
